

ATHLETIC AFTER SCHOOL POLICY

TEACHERS' RESPONSIBILITY:

1. Post a sheet of paper outside the classroom for students to sign up to seek review after school. This sheet is then put into a binder for proof that a student wanted extra help.
 - a. Teacher keeps the athlete for help or work until student's needs are met academically.
2. If any teacher wants to see an athlete after school but is worried the athlete may not show or cannot reach the athlete during the day, they are to notify the coach through the phone or e-mail. All outside coaches will provide phone contacts and e-mails so teachers can notify coaches that day that a student will be late for practice. They will also notify Mr. McCann through phone or e-mail. The athlete's saying, "I can't, I have practice" will not be a valid excuse. This includes any after school activity or club that is meeting.
3. If a teacher wants to see an athlete but hasn't seen him or her, the teacher must notify Mr. McCann and the coach through the phone or e-mail that the athlete needs to report to the teacher and will be late for practice.
4. If discipline is an issue the teacher will e-mail or call the coach or Mr. McCann that a certain athlete needs to see them before they can practice.

ATHLETES' RESPONSIBILITY:

1. If athletes are seeking extra help, they should sign up on the sheet outside the teacher's door or notify the teacher so they can write their name on the sheet.
 - a. The athletes stay there until their academic needs are met.
2. If an athlete needs to stay for extra help or participation in a club or activity, the coaches and Mr. McCann will be notified.
3. The athlete must understand that if a teacher wants to see him/her that day, the student is not to say "I can't, I have practice." This is not an acceptable excuse.
4. If a teacher wants to see an athlete after school for any disciplinary reason, the athlete must go see that teacher right after school.
5. A 'pass' must be provided by the athlete to the coach to verify their whereabouts and time excused.

COACHES' RESPONSIBILITY:

1. Coaches working at school will have their sheet posted outside their door and will keep a binder log on who needs to see them after school.
2. Understand and accept the fact that some athletes will be late for practice for a various amount of reasons. Coaches are not to interfere in school related matters for athletes being late.
3. Coaches will have cell phone and e-mails available during the day to check to see if there are any athletes reporting late to practice. Mr. McCann or the teacher will notify the coach if keeping an athlete after school is needed.
4. All coaches will provide e-mails and cell phone information to the school to make reaching them during the day a possibility.
5. Coaches understand that if a teacher claims an athlete told them he/she cannot stay after school because the coach says "I have practice" then the situation will be investigated and addressed by the athletic director.

PARENTS' RESPONSIBILITY:

1. To make sure their son or daughter abide by the above format.
2. The school is looking for parental support in helping make this a successful venture.
